We have a pool of almost 1,900 active seafarers, of which 900 are on-board vessels at any one time.

Technical management

Dockendale offers customised maintenance and repair for vessels and prides itself on the attention to detail it gives to each and every job. Clients benefit from our belief in transparency and open communication. We operate an 'open door' policy whereby clients visit to see first-hand how we care for their vessels.

Crew management

When hiring crew, Dockendale emphasises technical knowledge, expertise, leadership and the ability to take the initiative. Our crew are highly adept in running and maintaining vessels over long voyages and dealing with any contingencies and emergencies, should they arise.

All crew members undergo training and evaluation to ensure full preparation and compliance with health and safety standards.



VESSEL OWNING

Our long-term relationships with first-class shipbuilders, primarily in Japan, allow us to offer our clients increasing access to high-quality, modern, fuel-efficient vessels capable of delivering across a broad range of freight and trade routes.

We own a fleet of 37 vessels ranging from 27,000 to 66,000 dwt, and have 17 vessels on long term charter.

Our vessels include open hatch box-shaped geared bulk carriers, fully log-fitted, fully craned and most with grabs, further adding to the range of locations we can serve and the speed at which we can operate.

We take very seriously our responsibilities to the environment and to our people, and we report on what we are doing. We are committed to reducing the environmental impact of our activities and operating to the highest ethical standards. MUR vessels have many features that improve energy efficiency or lessen their environmental impact.

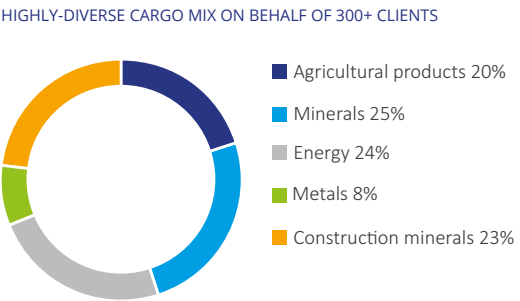

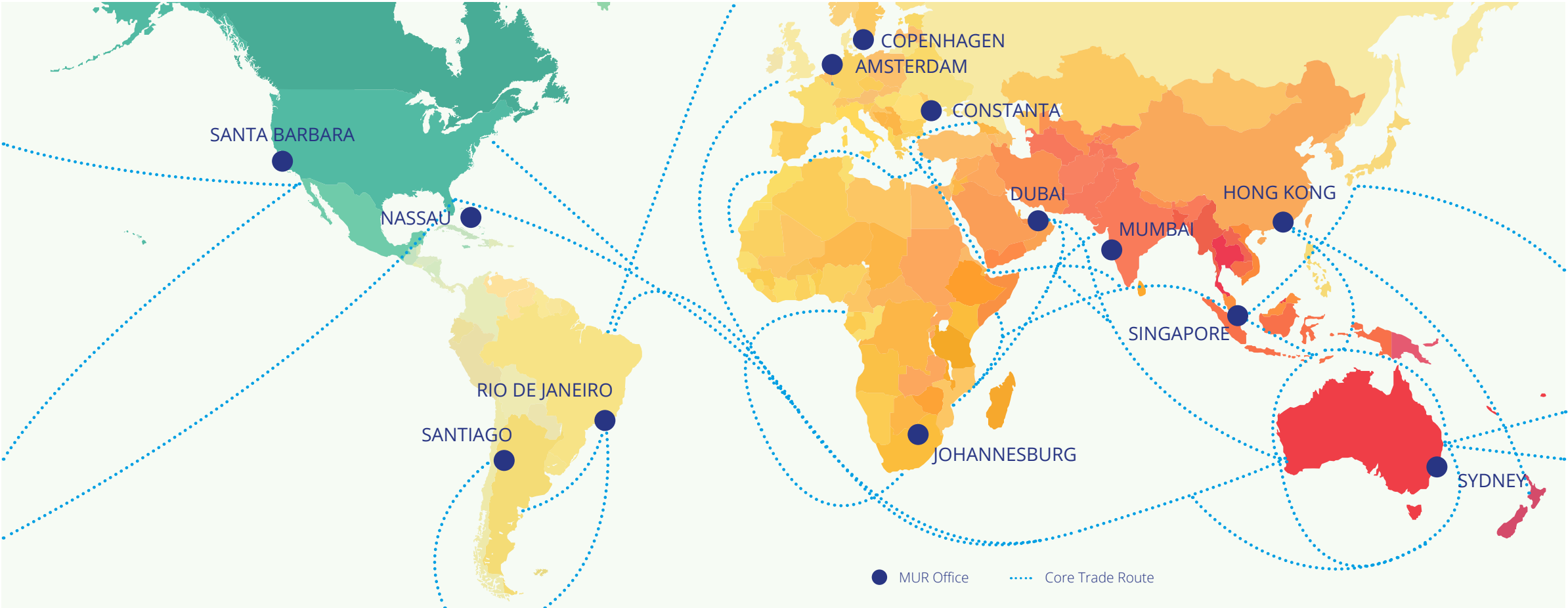
